<i>Acaena saccaticupula</i>	Blue Goose Leaf	Sun	6"	12"	12"	5	This evergreen groundcover hugs the ground with delicate, scalloped, bluish leaves on bronze, trailing stems. White flowers appear on short stalks in midsummer, followed by russet, ornamental seed heads. Ideal as an overplanting for bulbs, perched atop a garden wall, or surrounding stepping stones.
<i>Ajuga reptans</i> 'Black Scallop' PP#15,815	Carpetbugle	Shade	4"	12"	12"	4	Add a little low-maintenance elegance to your yard with this gorgeous groundcover. Also thriving in containers, the large, deep burgundy leaves are glossy and scalloped. When grouped with shades of white and gold, the contrast is dramatic! Deep blue spikes of flowers add to the appeal in late spring.
<i>Anacyclus depressus</i>	Mount Atlas Daisy	Sun	4"	12"	12"	4	Gray-green foliage spreads to form a lush carpet, covered with daisy-like flowers in early summer. Emerging from red buds, the white petals are red underneath. Excellent groundcover for dry, sandy soil and along pathways!
<i>Anthemis nobilis</i> (<i>Chamaemeleum nobile</i>)	Chamomile	Sun	6"	6"	6"	5	Achieve a handsome, cottage garden look with this popular, European groundcover! Small, daisy-like flowers adorn this cushion of downy foliage throughout the summer. Hardy enough to withstand mowing! Excellent in tea or as a rinse to brighten blonde hair.

Deadhead to encourage more flowering and keep this perennial neat. Adds year-round interest when planted as a groundcover or tucked into rock gardens and borders!
<i>Arabis ferdinandi-coburgii</i> 'Old Gold'	Variegated Rock Cress	Sun	2"	18"	18"	6	Small, white flowers rise above basal rosettes of deep green leaves, edged in gold. The thick mat of vegetation will brighten the ground around shrubs and looks great at the forefront of borders!
<i>Arabis sturrii</i>	Wall Cress	Sun	5"	12"	12"	5	Wall Cress is a favorite for rock gardens in hot, humid locales. The compact beauties sport dark green, glossy rosettes of leaves graced with clusters of pristine, four-petaled flowers on delicate stalks in early spring. Hardy and low-maintenance!
<i>Arenaria balearica</i>	Corsican Sandwort	Sun	1"	12"	12"	4	Shiny, nearly circular leaves form a light green, lush carpet that thrives in infertile, sandy soils. White, star-shaped flowers cover this enthusiastic spreader in spring. Corsican Sandwort is an excellent choice for coastal areas and close proximity to pavement.
<i>Arenaria montana</i> 'Avalanche'	Sandwort	Sun	2"	8"	12"	4	Silvery-white flowers appear in spring and summer, looking almost too big for the plant to handle! This hardy, low-growing selection with its mossy mat of green foliage will fit nicely into a wall or rock crevice where its trailing stems are shown off to full advantage. Deadhead the flowers to prevent self-seeding and spreading.
<i>Armeria maritima</i> 'Nifty Thrifty'	Sea Pink	Sun	4"	8"	12"	4	For the first time, an <i>Armeria</i> has striking green and white variegated foliage! Small, compact mounds grass-like foliage are excellent for tucking into small nooks in rock gardens. Able to withstand light foot traffic, 'Nifty Thrifty' is an excellent choice for surrounding stepping stones. Clusters of pink blooms emerge from the leaves on small stems in summer!
<i>Armeria maritima</i> 'Splendens'	Sea Pink	Sun	6"	8"	12"	3	Small, compact mound of deep green, grass-like foliage are excellent for tucking into small nooks in rock gardens. Able to withstand light foot traffic, 'Splendens' is an excellent choice for surrounding stepping stones. Clusters of bright pink blooms emerge from the leaves on small stems from spring until fall!

The leaves are aromatic when crushed and able to withstand light foot traffic. Enjoy the fragrance when it grows around walkways and stepping stones!
<i>Aurinia saxatile</i>	Basket-of-Gold	Sun	12"	12"	12"	3	A mat forming perennial with bright yellow flowers. Useful as a groundcover. Bright yellow flowers combine beautifully with the purples of Verbena and Salvia. An attractive groundcover for rock gardens and containers.
<i>Bellium minus</i>	Miniature Daisy	Sun	3"	6"	6"	6	A lush mat of tiny, light green leaves is blanketed with tiny, white daisies in early summer. Less than an inch in height, this is a dramatic groundcover for areas too shady for Red Creeping Thyme! Some foliage may die in winter, but this perennial readily self-seeds.
<i>Carex berggrenii</i>	Sedge	Sun	3"	6"	8"	5	Tufts of coppery, evergreen leaves are eye-catching additions to rock gardens, containers, or other moist sites in need of groundcover. The metallic color is most vivid when grown in full sun. Short, brown flower spikes appear in mid-spring.
<i>Cerastium alpinum</i> subsp. <i>lanatum</i>	Alpine Mouse Ear	Shade	4"	12"	12"	4	The pale grey, felt-like leaves beg to be touched, so keep this groundcover close! Consider this fuzzy carpet as a lawn replacement for sparingly-used areas. The sprinkling of white flowers that sparkle in the summer sun only add to this gem's appeal.
<i>Cymbalaria muralis</i>	Kenilworth Ivy	Shade	3"	6"	6"	3	Small, delicately edged, green leaves will meander through your garden wherever they're allowed. Blooming throughout the spring and summer, white flowers have two upper petals etched in lavender and dollops of yellow on the lower ones. Only tolerating light traffic, this is an excellent perennial to place beneath trees or along the sides of walkways!
<i>Delospermum nubeginum</i>	Ice Plant	Sun	2"	12"	12"	5	Star-like, orange-yellow flowers bloom in spring and continue for 4-6 weeks. A terrific plant for a dry, sunny location with succulent foliage. Good on banks and in rock gardens. Cut back after flowering for best results.

Dianthus 'Eastern Star' PP#14,437	Border Pinks	Sun	5"	12"	12"	5	Ruby-red flowers with deep burgundy centers. Asexual propagation prohibited. One of the exciting new Dianthus in the Star Series featuring long blooming characteristics with compact, mounding foliage. Its easy to celebrate this old garden favorite with new selections like this!
Dianthus 'Neon Star' PP#14,549	Border Pinks	Sun	5"	12"	12"	5	New selection of old garden favorite with bright, neon magenta flower form. One of the exciting new Dianthus in the Star Series featuring long blooming characteristics with compact, mounding foliage. Asexual propagation prohibited.

Erigeron scopulinus	Rock Fleabane	Sun	4"	12"	12"	3	Surround stepping stones and lawn ornaments with lush mats of rich green foliage guaranteed not to overwhelm. The daisy-like flowers will brighten any area of your garden in spring. After the leaves drop, the remaining stems will create winter interest.
Erodium x reichardii 'Charm'	Crane's Bill	Sun	4"	12"	12"	6	This low, matting perennail is a wonderful choice for sunny areas around shrubs and roses or along walkways where it can bear light foot traffic. The gray-green round leaves will compliment any neighboring plants. Rosy flowers have veins etched in shades of raspberry, decorating the vegetation from spring until fall! Keeping its crown dry will help it weather the winter.
Erodium x variabile 'Bishop's Form'	Alpine Geranium	Sun	4"	12"	12"	5	A pink cousin of Erodium 'Album', displaying charming rose-pink cupped flowers. A low-mounding geranium relative that brings long-flowering beauty to sunny borders, rock gardens or in mixed containers. Pink cupped flowers are accented with deeper pink veins.

<i>Erysimum kotschyanum</i> 'Orange Flame'	Wallflower	Sun	3"	8"	8"	4	Always popular as a groundcover, Wallflowers are tough and reliable in dry, sunny areas. The rich green leaves have jagged edges that compliment roses well. Small, vibrant orange blooms with four petals appear in early spring with those of Crocuses and Forsythia, considering overplanting the bulbs and surrounding the shrubs for a riot of color! The foliage forms cushions that are evergreen in warm climates!
<i>Glechoma hederacea</i> 'Variegata'	Ground Ivy	Sun	2"	18"	24"	4	Popular in hanging baskets for its cascading foliage, Ground Ivy is also an excellent groundcover for sunny areas with light foot traffic. Round, scalloped leaves are an emerald green with creamy, irregular markings along the margins. Spikes of small purple blooms appear in mid-spring, adding to the plant's cool elegance. As it will spread easily, mowing or a hard pruning will help keep this groundcover tidy.
<i>Houstonia caerulea</i>	Bluets	Sun	4"	8"	8"	4	Such enormous flowers for such a small plant! This lovely native has pale blue flowers with golden eyes above basal rosettes of low-growing foliage. This hardy groundcover tolerates light foot traffic and trimming. Bluets will thrive in the moist soil beneath Rhododendrons and Azaleas. Also an excellent addition for the foreground of borders and woodland settings!
<i>Iberis sempervirens</i> 'Purity'	Hardy Candytuft	Sun	4"	8"	8"	4	Looks like a winter snowfall when in bloom. This clumping variety is also known for longer lasting flowers. Grow this among deciduous shrubs for added interest in the shrub borders.
<i>Iris cristata</i> 'Eco Bluebird'	Dwarf Crested Iris	Shade	6"	12"	12"	5	Dainty flowers of cornflower-blue compliment miniature upright foliage. Great in a woodland setting where the 1st flowers of spring bring unexpected surprise.
<i>Lotus corniculatus</i> 'Plenus'	Bird's Foot Trefoil	Sun	3"	12"	12"	2	Sturdy perennials that will thrive in nearly any sunny environment are always a wise investment! The plant forms a low, spreading mound of emerald leaves that is covered in double, golden, pea-like flowers in summer. Thriving in poor soil and hot, sunny areas, consider this as a lawn substitute. Divide in spring or fall to spread and regular mowing will keep this semi-evergreen joy tidy.
<i>Lysimachia japonica</i> 'Minutissima'	Money Wort	Shade	3"	6"	6"	5	Look no further for an excellent groundcover to surround stepping stones and pathways! It can also be a charming lawn substitute for areas with limited foot traffic. This miniature Money Wort grows best in moist condition, but will tolerate nearly anything. A plush carpet of tiny, oval leaves spreads as stems root whenever they touch the ground and remains evergreen in warmer climates. Star-like, yellow flowers are a cheerful sight when they cover the foliage in early summer.

A shady ground cover, 'Home Fires' forms a dense cover in low light. Rich pink flowers are held upward on delicate stems, putting this Phlox in a class of its own. Plant with Monarda and Asters.
Phlox stolonifera 'Sherwood Purple'	Creeping Phlox	Shade	8"	12"	12"	2	An abundance of deep-violet flowers top lush green foliage. Useful as a groundcover or trailing perennial in a container. A shady groundcover, 'Sherwood Purple' forms a dense cover in low light. Deep-violet flowers are held upward on delicate stems, putting this Phlox in a class of its own. Plant with Monarda and Asters.
Potentilla crantzii 'Pygmaea'	Cinquefoil	Sun	3"	8"	12"	3	Runners and leaves with delicate edging and silvery hairs create a semievergreen carpet. Spreading quickly and tolerating light traffic, it ideally surrounds evergreen shrubs and flagstones. Yellow, buttercup-like flowers smother the foliage in summer.
Primula capitata 'Noverna Deep Blue'	Primrose	Shade	5"	10"	10"	6	Elegant, intensely colored, deep-blue flower heads rise on white powdery stems in whorls above the leaves. Prefers rich, slightly moist soils
Sagina subulata	Irish Moss	Sun	3"	8"	12"	4	Irish Moss is a low, mat-forming perennial whose emerald foliage has a unique, moss-like texture that begs to be touched. Its soft appearance is even lovelier in spring when sprinkled with translucent white flowers. Only reaching an inch tall, this plant is perfect for surrounding stepping tones or showcasing garden ornaments that would otherwise be hidden.

Ideally suited for pathways and the foreground of borders, this deep green mat is smothered in happy, yellow flowers during the summer and adopts a red hue during the winter. Although Goldmoss Stonecrop is a poor climber, it looks marvelous when allowed to spill over rocks, walls, or the edges of containers!
Sedum hispanicum 'Minus Purple Form'	Stonecrop	Sun	2"	8"	8"	3	Sedums have long been a favorite option for little nooks and crannies in the garden with their succulent leaves and showy flowers! Ideally suited for pathways and the foreground of borders, bluish-green leaves are topped by pale pink flowers in summer. The foliage offers year-round interest as it progresses from bluish-green to a deep blue in autumn and finally becomes a regal shade of purple in winter. Although Blue Carpet Stonecrop is a poor climber, it looks marvelous when allowed to spill over rocks, walls, or the edges of containers!
Sedum lineare 'Variegatum'	Stonecrop	Sun	4"	6"	6"	4	Carpeting groundcover with creamy-white margins along tiny, green succulent foliage. This tough, vigorous plant thrives in both sun or shade. A real winner for those hard-to-plant nooks and crannies, in rockeries or along a border path.
Sedum lydium	Stonecrop	Sun	2"	8"	8"	5	Sedums have long been a favorite option for little nooks and crannies in the garden with their succulent leaves and showy flowers! Ideally suited for pathways and the foreground of borders, this olive green mat is blanketed in snowy, white flowers during the summer and adopts a coppery-red hue during the winter. Although it is a poor climber, this perennial looks marvelous when allowed to spill over rocks, walls, or the edges of containers!
Sedum spurium 'Voodoo'	Stonecrop	Sun	4"	12"	12"	3	Mahogany-red succulent leaves complimented by clusters of rosy-red flowers. Creates good color contrast in rock gardens, at the front of the border, and as an edging or carpeting groundcover. Sure to cast its spell in any sunny garden! Darkest foliage of all the low-growing sedums. Blooms in summer.

The leaves are aromatic when crushed and the fragments generated from foot traffic will take root and spread the groundcover further. rance can be enjoyed when it grows around walkways!

Thymus x 'Spicy Orange'	Spicy Orange Thyme	Sun	4"	8"	8"	5	Spicy Orange Thyme is one hard-working perennial! Already a stellar groundcover and container element tough enough for a fair amount of foot traffic, this fragrant herb can also be used in cooking or teas, combining the flavors of allspice and orange. Evergreen in warmer climates, light green, needle-like leaves form a fragrant carpet when trod on and pink, summer flowers. Foliage becomes red-tinged in winter. Highly recommended!
Veronica liwanensis	Speedwell	Sun	3"	6"	6"	4	Blue is a rarity in the plant kingdom, so imagine being able to blanket vast spaces with this prized color! A creeping mat of dense, glossy, green foliage is completely covered in cobalt blue flowers in spring. Border sunny pathways and areas of light traffic with this show-stopper.
Veronica oltensis	Speedwell	Sun	1"	24"	24"	4	How can you do without such a versatile, low-maintenance addition to your garden? This long-lived groundcover is drought-resistant and slow growing. Tiny, dark green leaves will blanket rock gardens and sunny spaces and cascade over walls. In spring the foliage is virtually invisible beneath a blanket of tiny, azure blue blooms!

Viola pedata	Bird's Foot Violet	Shade	3"	6"	6"	4	One of our best-loved native flowers! Lovely, flat-faced, lilac flowers with prominent orange stamens and pale "beards" flutter above leaves so deeply dissected that they resemble a birds' foot. Naturalizing easily, this groundcover is a great way to achieve a woodland look!
